Rules for the Southern Delaware EAAHSC show

1. Be sure to nominate your horse for the J.C. (Steve) Stamper Founders Perpetual Hi-Point Trophy, which will be awarded to the horse who accumulates the most number of points at the Southern Delaware show. The trophy will be presented at the Year-End Awards Banquet in November. The points will be calculated by awarding points as follows: 1st-6, 2nd - 5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, 6th-1 multiplied by the number of horses in the respective class. All mandatory classes count towards this award.
2. There are two Walk-Trot classes for exhibitors aged 13 & over. Horse and rider combination entered in either of these two classes may not show in any other class (rider can compete in other classes on another horse or horse can compete in other classes with another rider).
3. LIGHTS OUT!! Please make note that due to increased electrical fees, the arena lights will be turned off at 10PM, and barn lights will be turned off at 11PM. Thank you in advance for your understanding.
4. Schooling over fences will be permitted in Ring 2 in the morning until the official courses are posted. Courses will be posted outside the in-gate of Ring 2 at approximately 8:30am. The ring will then be closed to exhibitors until classes begin. Exhibitors will be permitted to walk the course without their horses after the course is posted.
5. The Working Hunter Championship will be calculated by awarding points as follows: 1st-6, 2nd - 5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, 6th-1. In the case of a tie, the entry with the most points in the Handy Hunter class will win the tie.
6. Any discrepancies will be resolved by using EAAHSC rules and by-laws or by the EAAHSC Southern Delaware show committee.
