

## Year End High Point Awards

To be eligible for Year End High point awards the owner of the horse along with the exhibitor of the horse (if different) must be members of EAAHSC for the calendar year.

High Point Award points shall be awarded for each regular class on the basis of six (6) points for first place, five (5) points for second place, four (4) points for third place, Three (3) for fourth, two (2) for fifth place and one (1) for sixth place and in each case multiplied by the number of the horses actually shown in and completing the class.

For example if you win a class with 10 entries you would receive 60 points (6 x 10 = 60)

All points will be awarded to the horse except for the following classes the points will be awarded to the exhibitor.

Grooming & Showmanship

Lead Line / Walk of Lead

The following mandatory classes are individual class yearend highpoint award (see mandatory classes):

1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,21,23,24,25,26,27,28

The Points accumulated from all classes in the following divisions will count towards the division yearend highpoint award (see mandatory classes below):

12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,22,29,30

### **Special Awards:**

**Laura Carlson Award** - Junior Exhibitor accumulating the most points from all mandatory classes.

**Exhibitor of the Year** – Exhibitor over 18 accumulating the most points from all mandatory classes.

**Horse of the Year** – The horse accumulating the most points from all mandatory classes.

\*\*\*All year end awards must be picked up at the awards banquet the club will not mail awards.
